Host Club

North Flathead Yacht Club, Somers, Montana will be the host club and organizing authority for the Flathead Lake Laser Championship, to be held August 20th – 21st, 2011. See attachment A for location of the yacht club.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as amended by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility and Entry

All Laser sailboats and Laser sailors are welcome. No master's categories will be acknowledged. Rigs may be swapped (4.7, Radial, Full and back) at anytime (on land only) throughout the event. All sails must have the same sail number if swapping between rigs.

Laser sailors may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to North Flathead Yacht Club, P.O. Box 208, Somers, Montana 59932. Entries will be accepted, on site, up to the day of the race.

Fees

Adult registration: \$35

Youth (age 16 and under) registration: \$25

- On Course Race Warning Signal for **Youth Laser Sailors** 1:00pm, no races for **Youth Laser Sailors** will be started after 3:30pm
- Awards ceremony after Racing

All Laser sailors are welcome to race in the Adult Laser races. Youth Laser races are limited to sailors up to and including 16 years old. Adult racing will be in the morning and youth racing will be in the afternoon. The adult races and youth races will **not** run concurrent and are not expected to be raced on the same course. Adult races will be sailed on a course set approx 1 mile out in the lake taking advantage of the steady morning thermal. The youth race course will have shorter legs and be set closer to the yacht club docks. A total of ten (10) races are scheduled for both adult and youth. Two (2) races qualify as a regatta. If more than five (5) races are completed there will be one (1) throw out race.

Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at the time of race registration.

Facility

The North Flathead Yacht Club has ample lawn space for tent camping and ample parking lot space for RV camping at no charge. Rest room and shower facilities are available at no charge. There are no RV hookups or dump station. There are good launching and storage facilities for Lasers and dollies prior to and throughout the regatta.

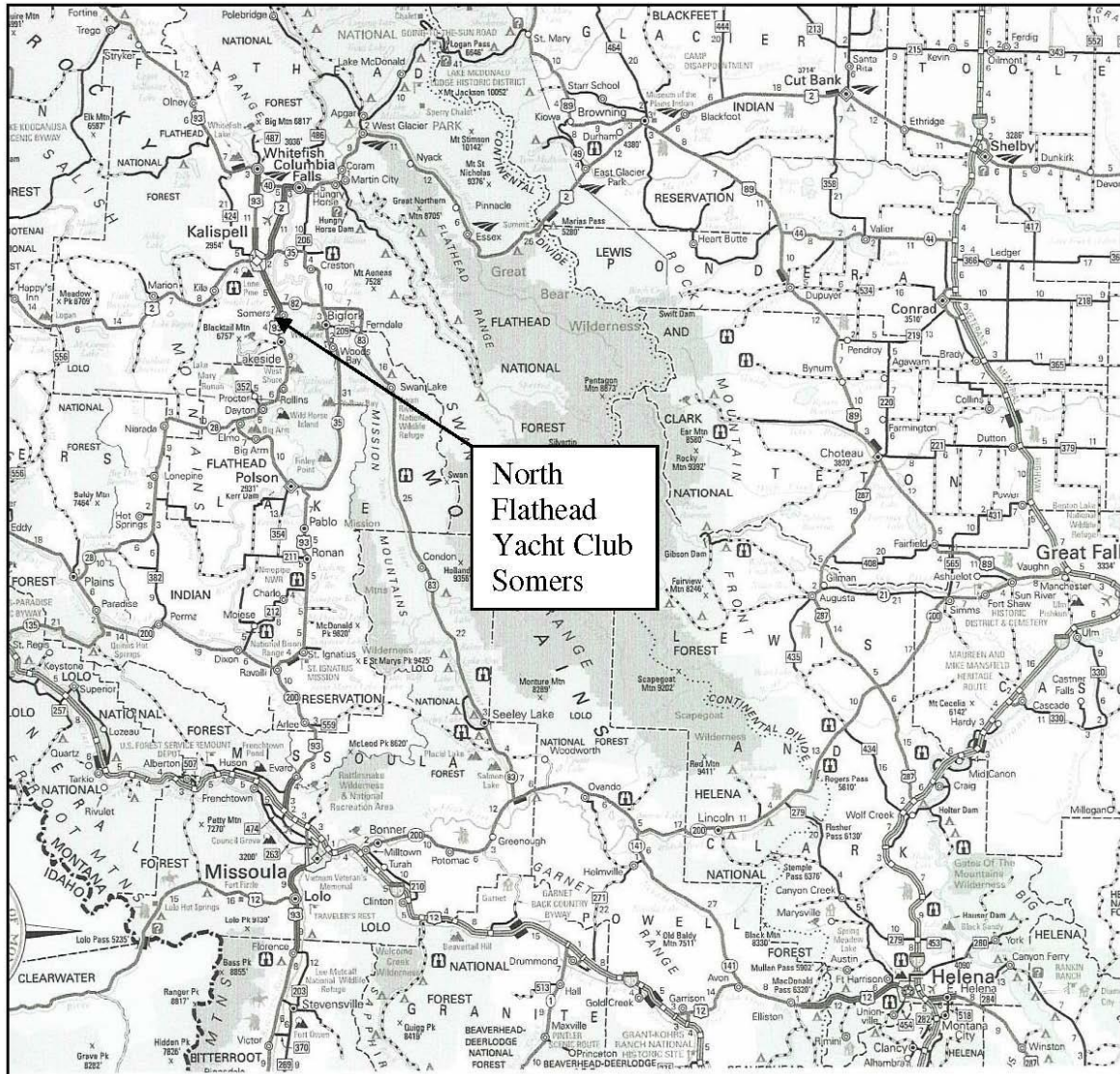

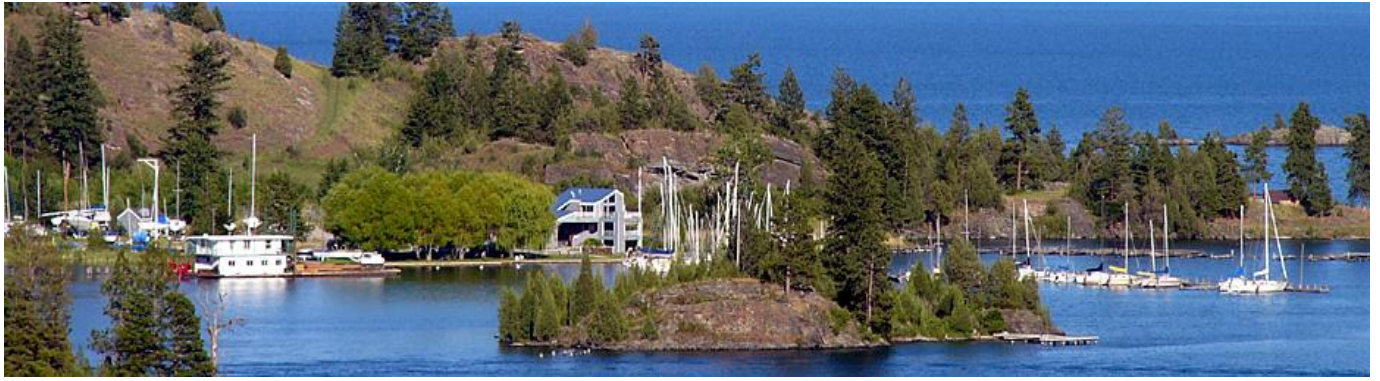
