Notice of Race

Host Club

North Flathead Yacht Club, Somers, Montana will be the host club and organizing authority for the Montana Sailing Championship.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing, The Montana Cup Deed of Gift, the prescriptions of PHRF, Class rules for One Designs, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions and Amendments thereto.

Eligibility and Entry

There may be up to five open fleets to be determined by quantity and type of yachts entered. In addition, classes with a minimum of five one-design boats registered may be given their own start at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to North Flathead Yacht Club, P.O. Box 208, Somers, Montana 59932 by Monday August 1, 2016. Late entries will be accepted at a higher fee until the first day of racing.

Fees

Registration received before August 1: \$95 per boat

Late Registration: \$120 per boat

Saturday night dinner: \$15 per person,

Measurement

Each boat shall report a rating according to Northern Rockies Sailing Association procedures or the North Flathead Yacht Club uses the Average value as shown in the United States Performance Handicap Racing Fleet High, Low, and Average Performance Handicaps. If your boat is not shown in the Handicaps, please contact the NFYC Vice Commodore by email at nfycvice@gmail.com or at the day of registration.

Sails may be measured at the discretion of the race committee.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be posted on the NFYC website http://www.nfyc.org/racing/nors/ and made available at registration.

Venue and Course

The racing venue will be the north end of Flathead Lake, Montana. The courses will be windward/leeward.

Berthing

North Flathead Yacht Club boats are assigned moorage at the North Flathead Yacht Club docks. Visiting boats shall be assigned a slip by the Port Captain and shall utilize the assigned moorage. Portsmouth boats may be stored on trailers in the parking area between races.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each fleet. The Montana Cup will be awarded to the club with the highest point total per the Montana Cup Deed of Gift.

Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000. Proof of insurance may be required.
