NFYC Junior Sailing Program

The Junior Program this year will be made up of basic sailing, and advanced sailing.

Basic sailing will involve learning to rig and sail an 8 foot Optimist sailboat or a larger boat for the teenagers, basic knot tying, boat handling, sailing etiquette, terminology and basic rules of the sea. They will have classes on Mondays and Wednesdays. Fridays will be for racing, any student is welcome to come who is ready to race and spend the class learning the rules of racing and practicing those rules.

Advanced sailing is for sailors who have been through the basic sailing class and are ready for advanced techniques. They will learn how to read the wind, roll tack, and be introduced to racing. Advanced classes will be on Tuesday and Thursdays. Fridays will be for racing, any student is welcome to come who is ready to race and spend the class learning the rules of racing and practicing those rules.

Students in the Junior Sailing Program must be at least 8 years old on the first day of class. Classes will begin the week of June 22nd for beginners and 23rd for advanced both at 8:30am-BE ON TIME to each lesson.

The Junior Sailing Regatta will be held August 15th. The Regatta will include races and games. It will begin at 9am and afterward, at 11am, there will be a Picnic for parents and sailors. Please put this date on your calendar.

Enrollment: To enroll, complete the attached application and enclose full payment. Due to class

size and boat availability, enrollment may be limited. Preference will be given to

NFYC general membership, followed by the date of application for junior

membership.

Fee: The junior sailing lessons are included with general membership NFYC fees. The Fee

for non yacht club members is \$175.00

Attire: US Coast Guard approved PFD (life jacket), swimsuit, shorts, t-shirt, sweatshirt, and a

towel, expect to get wet daily.

Swim Test: Conducted with a life jacket on. All participants will be required to swim 50 yards

unaided and tread water for 1 minute on the first day of class, no matter the weather.

Discipline: Behavioral problems will not be tolerated. Repeat offenders will be expelled.
