Notice of Race

North Flathead Yacht Club

August 5 – 7, 2011

Host Club

North Flathead Yacht Club, Somers, Montana will be the host club and organizing authority for the Montana Sailing Championships.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, The Montana Cup Deed of Gift, the prescriptions of PHRF, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions and Amendments thereto.

Eligibility and Entry

There may be up to four open fleets for displacement boats and one open fleet for non-displacement boats. Fleets will be determined by quantity and type of yachts entered. In addition, classes with a minimum of five one-design boats registered may be given their own start at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to North Flathead Yacht Club, P.O. Box 208, Somers, Montana 59932 by July 25, 2011. Late entries will be accepted at a higher fee until the first day of racing.

Fees

Registration postmarked or received **before** July 25: \$100 per boat

Late Registration: \$125 per boat

Saturday night dinner \$16 per person, T-Shirts \$15 ea.

Measurement

Each boat shall be assigned a rating according to Northern Rockies Sailing Association procedures. Sails may be measured at the discretion of the race committee.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be posted on the NFYC website www.nfyc.org or available at registration.

Venue and Course

The racing venue will be the north end of Flathead Lake, Montana. The courses will be windward/leeward.

Berthing

Boats shall be kept in their assigned moorage at the North Flathead Yacht Club docks. Portsmouth boats may be stored on trailers between races.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each fleet. The Montana Cup will be awarded to the club with the highest point total per the Montana Cup Deed of Gift.

Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000.
