Notice of Race

1 HOST CLUB

1.1 North Flathead Yacht Club, Somers, Montana will be the host club and organizing authority for the 2025 Tuesday Night Series.

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028."
- 2.2 Prescriptions of PHRF, the Sailing Instructions and all amendments thereto, will apply.
- A. The host club organizes registered boats into fleets based on handicaps.
 B. The Tuesday Night Series shall be governed by the PHRF of the Northern Rockies.
 Boats without ratings shall contact the host club and will be assigned a base rating.
 C. Specifications and measurements may be required to assign the base rating. Any adjustments will require a completed measurement form.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all displacement and non-displacement boats.
- 3.2 There will be four PHRF fleets for displacement boats and one fleet for nondisplacement boats.
- 3.3 Fleets will be determined by quantity and type of yachts entered. Fleets with a minimum of three one-design boats registered may be given their own start and fleet at the discretion of the organizing authority.
- 3.4 Boats may enter by registering on line at NFYC website: www.nfyc.org/racing. Registration can happen at any time during the series. Registration online helps our race committee organize the race and produce cleaner faster results.
- 3.5 Registration is not required for participation but is required to be scored and to be eligible for awards. Registration must be completed 24 hours prior to the start of a race to be scored.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows: There is no fee to register.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Every Tuesday from June 17 thru August 26. First warning horn at 7pm.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 The Tuesday Night Series shall be governed by the PHRF of the Northern Rockies. Boats without ratings shall contact North Flathead Yacht Club and will be assigned a base rating.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 Sailing instructions will be posted on the NFYC website: www.nfyc.org/racing.

8 VENUE

8.1 NFYC and the north end of Flathead Lake, Montana in Fish Hatchery Bay

9 STANDARD COURSES

9.1 Fleets A-D:The courses will be windward / leeward
A fleet will sail 2 long legs finishing to windward
B fleet will sail 1 long and 1 short leg finishing to windward
C and D Fleets will sail 2 Short legs finishing to windward
The Thistle fleet will sail 1 long and 1 short leg finishing to windward

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low-point scoring system.
- 10.2 One completed race constitutes a series.
- 10.3 If four or five races have been completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score.

If six or seven races have been competed, each boat's two worst scores will be excluded from her series score.

If eight or nine races have been completed, each boat's three worst scores will be excluded from her series score.

If ten or more races have been completed each boat's four worst scores will be excluded for her series score.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each fleet.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000. Proof of insurance may be required.
